



# 35<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL ART COMPETITION AND EXHIBITION: HIGH SCHOOL CATEGORY

The Central Bank of The Bahamas (the Bank) is proud to announce its 35<sup>th</sup> Annual High School/ Junior Art Competition and Exhibition to be held Thursday, November 8<sup>th</sup> to December 7<sup>th</sup>, 2018. The objectives of the competition are to identify, recognize, and encourage young Bahamians who demonstrate talent in the visual arts.

## REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION

To qualify, participants must be citizens of The Bahamas, currently enrolled in secondary school or a 2018 graduate, who are not involved in commercial sales of artwork.

## THEME

There are **no** restrictions as to the theme of works to be entered for the competition. However, works reflecting aspects of Bahamian culture and society and of an experimental nature are encouraged, as well as individualism.

## QUANTITY

Each artist must submit three (3) works in **ONLY** one of the following media:

• **Sculpture • Drawing • Painting • Print • Collage • Other pictorial presentation.**

Failure to present the required number of works results in disqualification from the competition and exhibition.

## GUIDELINES

The entries must meet the following requirements:

1. Each entry must be the authentic work of the participating artist.
2. In addition to the single general Application Form, each entry must be accompanied by a separate and completely filled Entry Form.
3. Repeat entries will not be accepted. Artists are encouraged to submit original works completed within the year.
4. Artists must demonstrate individualism, imagination in concept and in skillful use of materials.
5. Sculptures must be free standing or mounted on appropriate bases. There will be no restrictions on size and or material used. However, wood, stone and metal will be preferred. Additionally, the work must be appropriate for placement within the Gallery's space.
6. Paintings and drawings must be properly presented, and may be framed, or the artist may choose to omit framing as a part of the creative process. However, some works, such as color pencil art, must be framed so as to display in the gallery space. **All two dimensional works must have screw eyes and hanging wire, and must be able to be hung on the system that is in the Central Bank Gallery.**
7. Two-dimensional art works should be **no larger than 30 inches by 40 inches**. Works deemed too large or cumbersome to hang may not be accepted for exhibition. Works improperly prepared for display may be disqualified from the competition.

## CONDITIONS

1. All exhibited art works shall remain in the custody of the Bank for the entire period of the exhibition.
2. The Bank will not be responsible for loss or damage, except, at the discretion of the Bank, when such loss or damage is evidence as the direct result of a malicious act by the Bank.
3. All sales by the Bank, on behalf of artists, will be considered binding.
4. **All works must be collected within 10 days after exhibition's end. Works not collected will become part of collection of The Central Bank of The Bahamas or disposed of.**
5. All persons collecting works must present official form of ID and sign receipt of work(s).

## JUDGING

A panel of judges will select the award winning entries, which will be eligible to receive cash prizes. Scholarships will be awarded to deserving artists based on their overall presentation and the assessment by the judges. The scholarships will be tenable at the College of The Bahamas or any accredited tertiary institution outside The Bahamas for the study of art. Awardees who do not wish to study art will forfeit the awards.

## AWARDS

- First/Second/Third prizes to be awarded by the judges.
- Up to three Honorable Mentions may be awarded by the judges.
- Governor's Choice Award may be presented to the artist of one piece selected, independently of the competitions judges, by the Governor of The Central Bank of The Bahamas.
- Best Participating School award for the best overall participation in terms of the quality and quantity of work.
- Most Outstanding Sculpture Award to the sculptor exhibiting laudable ability and potential.
- Age 14 and Under Award to the high-school participant, age 14 or under, exhibiting the most promise.

Qualities such as originality of expression, individualism, creative use of materials and presentation are among some of the criteria considered. The judges reserve the right to disqualify any entry, where there is doubt as to authenticity. Winning entries will become the property of the Bank. Participants therefore enter this competition in agreement that the Central Bank be allowed to display winning pieces in any forum including but not limited to the Central Bank's website. All other entries may be offered for sale during the exhibition.

## APPLICATION FORMS

Entry Forms are available at the Bank or its website ([centralbankbahamas.com](http://centralbankbahamas.com)).

**All entries MUST be delivered to The Central Bank of The Bahamas no later than Wednesday, 17<sup>th</sup> October 2018. Late entries will NOT be accepted. The Grand Opening and Awards Presentation will take place on Thursday, 8<sup>th</sup> November 2018, at 6 p.m.**

## DIGITAL SUBMISSIONS

Applications may be digitally emailed to [artgallery@centralbankbahamas.com](mailto:artgallery@centralbankbahamas.com) prior to the delivery of the entries. In addition, a separate digital photograph for each entry should be submitted to the same email address. The three digital images should be in JPG or TIF format, with the file names consisting of the full name of the artist followed by the title of the work and the date of submission.

## NB:

Entries, submitted on time, will be judged. However, only works of the highest quality and presented in accordance with the guidelines will be exhibited. Works not exhibited will be stored for 10 days after the exhibition's opening. The Central Bank of The Bahamas will not be responsible for works left beyond this period.

All artworks must be collected from the Bank and the Gallery within 10 days after the exhibition's end.
